

CRITERIA FOR OCCC HALL OF FAME SELECTION

PURPOSE: Membership in the Ocean County Coin Club Hall of Fame is the highest honor bestowed upon a member of the club and is given in recognition of numerous years of outstanding, dedicated service to numismatics within the club.

CRITERIA: The nominee should be an individual who has rendered numerous years of outstanding service to the OCCC, a prior Club Numismatist of the Year and has contributed to the growth and success of the club.

Nominees for this award will be judged on the following:

- 1 - Minimum of ten years as active club member
- 2 - Offices held - title and year (s) - Minimum of two years
- 3 - Club duties that have furthered the growth of the club
- 4 - Published numismatic articles
- 5 - Numismatic presentations and show & tells
- 6 - Numismatic awards
- 7 - Numismatic collecting specialties
- 8 - Numismatic accomplishments
- 9 - A Club Numismatist of the Year selectee
- 10 - Placed numismatic exhibits at club shows and/or other locations

WAIVERS: In extreme instances, a waiver of any of the criteria will be considered.

INDIVIDUAL NOMINATIONS: The Club Selection Committee will also entertain Hall of Fame nominees from an individual other than a nominee, i.e, a former club member who has met the requirements may submit themselves for consideration.

COMMITTEE: The president will appoint a three member committee to review the nominees and make recommendations for selection to the president.

SUBMISSION: Nominations in sealed envelopes are to be forwarded to the Club Selection Committee either at a meeting or mailed to: OCCC, 65 - Sixteenth Street, Toms River, NJ 08753 no later than the first meeting in July for consideration by the committee in August. Results of the committee will be forwarded to the club president by the first meeting in September. Announcement and presentations will be conducted at the club's annual banquet in October or at the meeting thereafter for those unavailable.
